

CCHS Senior Painted Parking Spot

It's YOUR turn to paint your Senior Parking Spot!!!! Allowing senior students to paint their own parking spots is a great way to improve school pride! We encourage students to express themselves through positive artwork, to beautify the campus, to build school spirit and to create a tradition and support Senior Class activities and events.

Purchasing a Senior Parking Space allows the purchasing senior student to personalize their space by painting it. Funds raised will be used for Senior Class activities and events, such as Senior BBQ, Senior Week and others. Painting parking spots is a privilege. Non painted parking spaces will continue to be available for seniors who do not wish to purchase and decorate a parking spot.

To paint a parking spot, students must turn in the attached form, have a valid driver's license and current registration.

1. Requirements

- a. Students must purchase their own paint and supplies and be able to paint spot on assigned day
 - i. The attached contract must be completed and turned in before assigned painting day
 - ii. Painting cannot take place at any other time
- b. Must complete CCHS parking registration form before eligible to paint
- c. Must pay \$20 to be able to paint
- d. The parking spot is yours (not to be shared with friends) Tuesday – Friday 7:00 a.m. – 3:20 p.m.
- e. You will choose from designated spots and you must use that spot
- f. Students must clean spills and must discard all unused materials
- g. **Spots are first come first serve – You must be in person to reserve your spot – Forms may be turned in starting Monday, August 17th at 8 a.m. in the main office.**
- h. **Painting Day will be Friday, August 21st from 8 am – 3 pm.**

2. Materials Needed

- a. Latex paint – Exterior – Water Based
 - i. No oil based paints
 - ii. No reflective paints
 - iii. No spray paints
 - iv. No glitter
- b. Brushes, rollers or sponge to apply paint (nothing else permitted)
- c. Masking tape to mark off 4-inch border from white lines
- d. Stool or towel to sit on
- e. Chalk to sketch design
- f. Broom to sweep spot
- g. Plastic drop cloth to put under paint cans
- h. Plastic containers for water, paint and brushes
- i. Sunscreen, hats, sunglasses, water, snacks, etc.

3. Design Criteria

- a. No offensive language or gang symbols
- b. No double meanings
- c. No nicknames, girlfriend/boyfriend names, etc. (ONLY your own name)

- d. Must be school-appropriate
- e. Design must be approved by administration prior to paint day
- f. Prohibited items will be painted over in black at the discretion of the administration and disciplinary action may be taken
- g. You are not permitted to deviate from your submitted design nor alter your design at any time throughout the year

4. Painting Tips

- a. Tape the edge of your spot with a 4-inch margin before painting
- b. Do not paint on the white lines or parking lot curbs
- c. Sweep the dirt and pebbles off the spot before you paint
- d. Use chalk to draw out your sketch
- e. Start painting at the front of your spot out to the end (front bumper to back bumper) because there are others working beside you and you cannot step on their spot
- f. Consider making a stencil ahead of time for lettering or detailed images to save a lot of time
- g. Bring extra plastic containers (no glass) for water and brushes
- h. Bring a drop cloth or plastic sheeting to put under paint cans; NO paint is permitted outside your spot
- i. Limit your paint palette as the quarts of paint are expensive or share colors with a friend

5. End of the Year

- a. The student is responsible for painting over their spot at the end of the school year
- b. The school will make students aware of what day this will happen once that day is determined
- c. The school will provide the paint and supplies for students to cover their parking spots at the end of the year

Students are reminded that all student code of conduct and all local laws will be enforced regarding the Senior Painted Parking Spots. Wording or marks of alcohol, drugs, drug paraphernalia, slander, slang, racism, gangs or sexual connotation will lead to loss of privilege and/or punishment. At any time during the year, CCHS reserves the right to remove the Senior Painted Parking Spot if any of the above occurs. All paint, supplies and clean-up are the responsibility of the student.

Senior Parking Spot Design Request

This design sheet must represent exactly what will be painted on your parking space if it is accepted. This form needs to be completed for approval by administration prior to paint day. You may want to make a copy or take a picture of this before submitting.

Front Bumper (4-inch margin) NO PAINT

Reserved Senior Painted Parking Spot Contract

- **Painting day is Friday, August 21st 8 am – 3 pm**
- Upon purchasing my parking spot, I will only use water-based exterior latex paint
- I know I am not allowed spray paint, reflective paint, glitter or fluorescent paint of any kind
- I will only paint within the marked parking space
- I know I have to furnish my own brushes and painting supplies to decorate my spot
- I will never park in another parking space that is assigned to someone else or let anyone park in my space
- I will only paint my approved design following all the guidelines in my contract
- I understand that my sketched design must be completed and submitted to Mrs. Meyer before August 20th
- If I do not abide by any of these rules, I realize my parking spot will be taken away and will be painted over, and I will not receive a refund
- If I park in someone else's painted parking spot, I will be reported to administration with possible disciplinary action
- I know that I am responsible for painting over my spot at the end of the year with paint and supplies provided by the school
